Gather everyone who wants to participate. You can include friends, family and neighbours. Gather in front of the main entrance to your home.



## PREPARE

Decide who will read what parts and who will chalk the door. The roles can be shared. Have a stepladder handy if needed. Light the candle. Take a few moments of quiet before beginning.



Flip this card over and begin the liturgy. Everyone responds with 'Amen' at the end of each prayer.



Write this inscription above the outside of the door: 20 + C + M + B + current year, e.g. 21 The numbers make up the year and the letters represent the names of the Magi--Caspar, Melchior, Balthasar--and the Latin prayer, Christus Mansionem Benedicat--Christ bless this home.



Everyone says the Lord's Prayer together. Leave the chalk

inscription up until next year.

As the participants make the inscription above the door:

20 + C + M + B + current year e.g. 21 The leader says:

The three Wise Ones followed the star to Bethlehem and the home of Jesus two thousand, and twenty \_\_\_\_\_ years ago. May Christ bless our home, and remain with us throughout the year. **Amen.**
