In this 3-hour workshop you will make a purificator (the linen used to clean the chalice during the Eucharist). Skills covered will include: preparing the fabric, sewing mitred corners by hand, drawn-thread and other hemstitching techniques, chainstitch embroidery and more. These can then be used to make other Eucharistic linens such as corporals, palls, or even larger altar cloths.
